## What is Project ECHO?



Using a template, patient details are e-mailed to the host prior to the scheduled meeting



Hosted by the Liverpool Hospital Hepatology team (Specialist, nurse, social worker, pharmacist) de-identified patients are discussed



Host generates letters confirming the plan for each patient. Patients get optimal care with the team they are most comfortable with: You!.
